CHILDREN'S PRICES
 Children under 12 are admitted free when accompanied by adults who purchased tickets in **advance**. Otherwise it's \$2 per child at the gate. Kids 12 and over are full price.

TENT CAMPING & PARKING FEES
 Tent camping is free for those holding tickets for three or more consecutive days. Otherwise it's \$5 per night per person. In order to maximize tent space in the campgrounds, **transportation vehicles in the campgrounds are \$20 per day** (refundable \$20 one-hour unloading permits will be issued at the gate). Parking is FREE in the parking meadow. No camping permitted in the parking meadow.

SLEEPER VEHICLES
 Obvious sleeper vehicles such as vans, pick-ups with camper shells, etc. will be charged a single \$20 fee upon entry. As long as the vehicle doesn't leave its spot, no additional fees will be required. \$20 will be charged for **EACH** re-entry to the ranch.

RV SITES
 A limited number of RV hook-ups sites are available in the campgrounds. Sites with water/electricity/sewer are \$25 per night. Sites with water/electricity only (for small campers and pop-ups) are \$20 per night. RV site occupants can keep one tow vehicle on their pad. Reservations required. Restrictions may apply.
